► On the Day of the Event - <u>Opening The Staging Location</u> :				
SL Leadership - Arrive 1 hour before the first shift of the day begins. This is necessary to prep and organize materials				
and verify the office is open for the opening report, and to make sure any early arrivals can get started on

- If Undecided Ask about the issue that matters to them and have a shared values conversation to build connection between the voter, volunteer, and the candidates.
- If Strong / Support Help the voter make a detailed plan to vote.
 - Where? Confirm their polling location, and ensure they know where it is.
 - When? Will they vote early, by mail, or in-person? Before or after work?
 - How? How will they get to the polls? Where will they be coming from?
 - Research shows these questions increase likelihood of voting by 4.1%[±]





How *Project 2025*Will Harm Wisconsinites

Project 2025 is a 900-page agenda that former top Trump administration officials (and likely future officials) produced to guide him in implementing their radical agenda as quickly as possible. To achieve this, they would (1)immediately fire experienced civil servants, replacing them with untrained MAGA devotees, and (2) remove the "guardrails" of democracy, which previously prevented President Trump from pursuing



some of his most harmful proposals. Here are some of the worst proposals:

Restrict Medicare

Project 2025 plans would undo Medicare's ability to negotiate lower prescription prices for 1.2 million people in Wisconsin. Even without repealing the Inflation Reduction Act (IRA), the Department of Justice (DOJ) would likely stop defending Medicare's ability to negotiate drug prices in courts. If the IRA were repealed, the monthly \$35 cap on insulin co-payments would disappear.

End Mortgage Assistance

In 2023, Fannie Mae and Freddie Mac provided mortgage assistance to 30,850 buyers in Wisconsin, enabling low and middle-class buyers to obtain a home with reduced down payments and lower mortgage rates. Project 2025 proposes to close down Fannie Mae and Freddie Mac so that "Barriers to private investment [are] removed to pave the way for a robust private market (p. 706).

Cut Back Federal School Funds

In 2023, the US Department of Education (DoE) awarded \$265 million to local education agencies in Wisconsin. The funds enable schools with low-income students to deploy scarce resources in ways that benefit all children. Project 2025 proposes to close down the DoE) and transfer some of its funds to states. The proposed cuts would result in an estimated loss of 2,641 teaching positions, which serve 36,188 students in Wisconsin.

In addition, Project 2025 proposes to eliminate the Head Start program, which provides targeted assistance to low income children. In 2023, the Head Start and Early Head Start programs enrolled 12,000 Wisconsin children.

Reduce Food Security Aid

5NAP assistance goes to 703,000 people (370,000 households) in Wisconsin. Project 2025 plan would "reform broad-based categorical eligibility" and restore stiff work requirements, cutting off many current recipients. 86% percent of recipient households in Wisconsin include a child, an elderly person, or a person with disabilities.


Cap Medicaid

595,300 Medicaid enrollees in Wisconsin would risk losing coverage under Project 2025's plan to impose limits or lifetime caps on benefits.


And More...

- Require the VA to revise "disability rating awards" by rejecting new claims for Agent Orange and Burn Pits/Airborne Toxins.
- Remove domestic protections for endangered species, other wildlife, and federally-owned lands.
- ➤ Weaken workers rights: end overtime pay guarantees and requirements that federally-funded projects have Project Labor Agreements would disappear.
- ➤ The more than 120,000 Wisconsinites with outstanding student loans enrolled in the SAVE Plan would need to pay between \$2,700 and \$4,000 more each year.
- ➤ Eliminate emergency contraception medications from free preventive care requirements, denying appropriate health care to 874,000 women in Wisconsin.
- Approximately 28,000 eligible Wisconsin Dreamers would be deported.
